



Straight Carmalts



Curved Carmalts



Both straight and curved are clamps with longitudinal grooves that clamp across a tubular structure such as a uterus or ovarian pedicle.

Spay Hook



Blunt-pointed hook for exteriorizing a uterine horn during a spay operation.

Straight Crile



Used as a hemostatic forcep to control bleeding &/or grip tissue.

Straight Hemostat



Curved Hemostat



Used to control bleeding, until sutures or other surgical techniques can repair the bleeding.



Olsen-Hegar Needle Holder



Used as a combination instrument for driving the needle, then cutting the suture without changing instruments.

Thumb Forcep



Used to hold tissue in place when applying sutures, to gently move tissues out of the way during exploratory surgery and to move dressings or draping without using the hands or fingers.

Metzenbaum Scissor



Surgical scissors designed for cutting delicate tissue.

Towel Clamps



Used to hold surgical drapes in place.
